

Arkansas PPAN Assessment Disclaimer

Ref. 2016 Arkansas Code Title 27 – Transportation Subtitle 2 – Motor Vehicle Registration and Licensing Chapter 14 – Uniform Motor Vehicle Administration, Certificate of Title, and Antitheft Act Subchapter 10 – Permanent Automobile Licensing Act, 27-14-1015. Payment of Personal Property Taxes and Listing for Assessment Required. AR Code 27-14-1015 (2016).

Arkansas State Statutes require all Arkansas Registered Drivers to show proof of paid Arkansas County Property Tax Assessment to register a newly purchased vehicle. You must show a valid receipt with your Arkansas PPAN number to legally title and register your new vehicle. For proper registration and/or lien filing for your bank, you must comply with Arkansas State Law by assisting and producing the Arkansas Property Tax Assessment Receipt. Any delay with assistance will result in late penalties from the State of Arkansas and/or legal action.

I understand that my involvement is required and necessary to complete/produce/acquire the Arkansas County Property Tax Assessment Receipt and I acknowledge that delays on my part will result in additional state taxes and fees.
