

Georgia Emissions Test Disclaimer

Ref. Rules and Regulations of the State of Georgia – Subject 391-3-20

Georgia State Statutes require all Georgia Registered Drivers purchasing a vehicle, for 2023 vehicle registration, if your vehicle is a 1999 – 2020 model year gasoline-powered car or light-duty truck (8,500 pounds gross vehicle weight rating or less) registered in Cherokee, Clayton, Cobb, Coweta, DeKalb, Douglas, Fayette, Forsyth, Fulton, Gwinnett, Henry, Paulding or Rockdale County, it must be emissions tested. You must bring your new vehicle to any Licensed Inspector in Georgia to obtain an Emissions Test to legally title and register your new vehicle. For proper registration and/or lien filing for your bank, you must comply with Georgia State Law by assisting and producing the Georgia IDOD Inspection. Any delay with assistance will result in late penalties from the State of Georgia and/or legal action.

I understand that my involvement is required and necessary to complete/produce/acquire the Georgia Emissions Test and I acknowledge that delays on my part will result in additional state taxes and fees.
