

Missouri Safety Inspection Disclaimer

Ref. Missouri Code Registration Title 11 / 50-2.440 & MODOR Notice Safety and Emissions Inspections and Required Equipment – Chapter 14.

Missouri State Statutes require all applicable Missouri Registered Drivers purchasing a vehicle that is 10 model years or older OR 150,000 miles or more, show proof of a valid Safety Inspection to register a newly purchased vehicle in Missouri. You must bring your new vehicle to any Licensed Inspector in Missouri to obtain a Safety Inspection to legally title and register your new vehicle. For proper registration and/or lien filing for your bank, you must comply with Missouri State Law by assisting and producing the Missouri Safety Inspection. Any delay with assistance will result in late penalties from the State of Missouri and/or legal action.

I understand that my involvement is required and necessary to complete/produce/acquire the Missouri Safety Inspection and I acknowledge that delays on my part will result in additional state taxes and fees.
